SMP Bowling Update

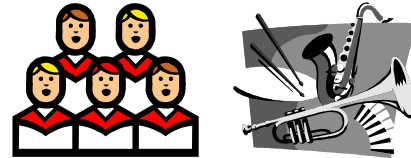
